Operations challenges

- Inefficient delivery scheduling leading to site congestion and high wait times
- No oversite as to what was coming to site in the future
- Incorrect allocation of loads to wrong contracts
- Over delivery of contracts and orders
- 图 Poor DIFOT metrics
- Limited traceability and manual declarations
- No data regarding freight provider and customer performance
- Manual delivery reconciliation with SAP

AgriChain solution

- Time slot management: Allows freight providers to book a slot of their choice
- Truck status and ETA: Provides status and ETA for each truck, with alerts if a truck is going to be late
- Slot booking rules: Ensures trucks don't over book or over deliver
- Message broadcasting: Communicates interruptions such as mill shutdowns to drivers
- Quantity overview: Provides total quantities of each grade being delivered during a day/week
- Detailed reporting: On each freight company's performance in terms of booking, cancellations, delays, etc.
- Truck and driver information: Complete details about the truck, driver, and contact number
- Integration with SAP: Keeps all systems in sync in real-time regarding deliveries
